Parent's Pre- Evaluation Check-off Column	Elements of a Portfolio	Evaluator's Suggestions/ Comments
	Letter of Registration	This is the formal letter you received from the county acknowledging that you are homeschooling. The date on this letter tells when your eval is due every year. If you don't know, call your county Homeschool Liaison.
	Curriculum List*	A bibliographical list of all text books/websites, etc. that you used to teach your child.
	Pleasure Reading List	This is a simple list of books read for pleasure by the student- Title and Author. Use library receipts, try Shelfari (Amazon.Com), or just a make a list. (It doesn't have to include every book the student read.)
	Daily Log*	Need 3 samples of this <u>dated</u> , ongoing record of what you did each day (in brief) in each subject. See power-point for great example. (Does not have to coincide with submitted work.)
	Graded Work Samples*	Include 3 <i>graded</i> , <u>dated</u> samples from each subject. <i>One each</i> from the <u>beginning</u> , <u>middle</u> , & towards the <u>end</u> of year. (Tests, videos, etc. count!) <u>Math Sci Hist LA etc.</u> √ √ √ √
	Special Projects / Awards	Photos/videos of fieldtrips, awards, projects, karate/dance class, etc.
